

San Dieguito River Culvert Survey/Recommendation

The San Dieguito watershed is one of 11 in San Diego County.

The [San Dieguito River Park](#) (SDRP) is the agency responsible for creating a natural open space park in the San Dieguito River Valley.

From the Coast to Crest Trail that will someday link trails and paths from Del Mar to Volcan Mountain - over 70 miles - to the celebration and preservation of our local heritage and natural resources, the San Dieguito River Park is creating recreational and educational opportunities that interface gently with nature.

Recent winter storms have eroded the space around one of the flow diverging culverts and could possibly be unstable.

Project is to determine the stability of their current system and to suggest replacement or redesign based on findings. Team is welcome to propose own design they feel is more suitable for the SDRP's issues, needs, and intentions.
